

Last Lunar New Year Holiday, my schoolmates and I went to the United States of America for Cultural Exchange with an American school, the Anne Mason Elementary school for ten days.

On the next day, we played some video games in the morning. Later on, we went to the aquarium, it took about an hour to get there. It was very big. I saw a lot of sea animals such as penguins, turtles and special fish. It was wonderful! It was my most unforgettable



experience on the trip! In the evening, we went to the high school to watch a basketball match. I thought it was boring.

On Sunday, we went to church and it took about two hours. After that, we played table tennis at the church! Then we went to Walmart. We met our teacher Miss Yau there. I bought many presents for my family. In the evening, we went to eat an Asian buffet. I didn't really like it.

We couldn't go to school on Monday because there was a big snow storm. The snow was about one foot deep. We built the snow wall again but I gave up because it was too cold! Then we had hot chocolate and biscuits.

On Tuesday, We built a snow wall with Quinton's friends, Kelvin. He was very strong and smart. Then we played some video games. In the evening, we went to the Anne Mason Elementary School to eat a small buffet and play some games.

It was our last day in America. We went to the library to read some books. Then Davy and I packed our suitcases in the afternoon. I would be very sad when I get back to Hong Kong. I would miss them.

We got up at six that morning. We were going to the airport again. I hope I can go back to America one day to visit Quinton and his family.





I was so happy I could join my school's exchange programme. During this trip, I learned more about Kentucky, their lifestyle and school life.

and Kentucky. The temperature is sometimes below 0 °C . Kentucky's food and drinks are different from Hong Kong's too.

The most different, is the school life. The students go to school at seven o'clock. They have their breakfast at school. In Hong Kong, our teachers take us to special rooms such as the computer room to have computer lessons. In Kentucky, on the contrary, the students go to the special rooms by themselves. 'They have subjects that we don't have such as History. Learning History is new to me. Their lunch break is not too much different from ours but the students can speak loudly while they are eating. During lessons, the students can eat and drink. I think the American education system is more free.

Their lifestyle is different too. They like to eat eggs, sausages and bread for breakfast. In Hong Kong, people usually eat bread, noodles and sandwiches for breakfast. Many Kentucky people live in remote areas, so they are very busy as it takes a long time to go from one place to another. The Americans are fatter because they like to eat fatty food. They always have chips and chicken. They also like to eat fried food and juice for lunch. They usually start their dinner at six o'clock and they usually buy takeaway food for dinner. The Americans go to bed earlier than Hong Kong people. They sleep at nine o'clock. Their lifestyle is very different from the lifestyle in Hong Kong. I learned more about the American and it was interesting to know more about another culture.

Buildings in Kentucky are different from buildings in Hong Kong too. Buildings in Kentucky are lower and dispersed. Buildings in Hong Kong are high and dense. Kentucky is a small state. The houses are much bigger than in Hong Kong. People have their own houses with gardens. The houses have two to three floors. The lowest floor is the basement. They put their used things and things they don't use often in the basement. On the ground floor is the living room, dining room, master bedroom and kitchen. In the living room, there is a furnace to keep them warm. On the second floor are the guest rooms. My classmate Melody and I stayed in a guest room on the second floor.

During the stay in Kentucky, we went to different places. We went to a children's science museum. The museum had many pavilions, for example, Bubble Zone, Gumball Room and Shadow Wall. The host family took me to Toyota Nursery. Kentucky has many nurseries. Hong Kong has many nurseries too.

I went to a sports centre with my host family. Their sports centre is not too much different from ours. There is a swimming pool, basketball courts, a fitness room and some activities room.

2010年4月9日,我隨著老師,前往江西南昌這座英雄之城,探訪我們的 結盟學校——豫章小學,亦順道遊覽名勝古蹟,此行除了讓我見聞大增之外, 亦讓我認識了不少朋友,真是一舉兩得。

南昌美譽為「英雄之城」,是因為在1927年8月1日,共產黨在這裡響起 了起義的第一槍,是<u>中國共產黨</u>武裝革命的開始。因此,到<u>八一起義紀念館</u> 參觀是這一次交流中最令我印象深刻的地方。當我們一踏進館裡,就看到一 支很巨大的火箭了,聽說是照著真實的火箭比例製造的,同學們都十分驚訝, 館內還展示了不少起義時的情況,圖文並茂,一張張的照片,一段段的文字, 讓大家感受到革命人士的壯烈及為著他人、國家犧牲的偉大情操,都讓同學 們為之震撼。導賞員及老師還帶著同學們到了一條漆黑,而不平的步道,並 著同學們一個一個地嘗試通過,體驗當時革命者行軍時的艱苦,同學都小心 翼翼地慢步走過,生怕有野獸或敵人突然來襲似的,可以想像在真實情況下, 戰仕們的心情;雖然導賞員姐姐也是一位軍官,但她十分友善,講解亦十分 詳盡。我對「八一起義」有更深的認識。

另一個令我印象深刻的地方是騰王閣,那天整天都下著大雨,而且 風勢頗大,很多同學的帽子、雨傘都差點被吹走了,十分狼 狽;可是仍無損我們參觀這座歷史悠久的建築物。我最 愛的是位於二樓的一副壁畫《人傑圖——江西 曆代名圖卷》。這幅壁畫描繪了歷史 上自先秦至清朝末年的八十

位江西籍名人,如<u>陶淵明</u>、<u>歐陽修</u>、王安石等,雖然大部分我都不太認識, 但同學都嘗試唸著他們的名字,講述他們的事蹟。

從學校的壁報看到一幅世界博覽會的照片,不禁令我們 回想起一連五天的尚德電力盃中國青少年創新大賽暨上海世博之旅,那是多麽令人難忘,多麽使人懷念啊!

第四天,大家懷着既愉快又輕鬆的心情向上海世界博覽會進發,一開眼界。我們一共參觀了八個展覽館,包括巴西館、荷蘭館、石油館、可口可樂館……展覽館的設計各有特色,別具風格。對我們來說,宏偉的中國館設計最為別緻,外形似鼎,亦似皇冠,運用中國古典建築「斗拱」的造型,以中國文字裝飾,一身紅色的展館充分展示中國的神韻。設計新穎的香港館及以活潑兔子造型的澳門館矗立在中國館兩旁,只見同學們紛紛忙着拍照留念。直到晚上,我們才依依不捨地離開會場。

我們十分慶幸有機會參加這個有意義的學習旅程,也深刻體會到尚德盃比賽的口號:「少年創意:世界創新」,這就是我們新一代的工作。願我們年

二零一零年三月,我們收到一份有關全國科學的比賽及參觀上 海世界博覽會的通告,我們毫不猶豫就報名去了,也順利入選,代表學 校前往上海參加比賽。

比賽之前,老師跟我們一起研究及製作太陽能水陸兩用車船及低碳校園計畫的作品。我們以為製作了一輛速度及效能還算不錯的太陽能車船,可以輕鬆應戰,突然收到一個「壞消息」,大會規定參賽者需要即席組裝零件。面對突如其來的驟變,心情也隨即焦急起來。後來,經過老師的提點,我們決定反覆練習組裝太陽能車船,待技巧純熟了,便不會感到害怕了。

七月二十七日,我們從<u>香港</u>出發,經過漫長的旅程,終於到達比賽場地一<u>江蘇省泰州中學。 泰州中學</u>在1902年創校,校舍面積有七萬平方米,教學設施齊全,包括游泳池、影劇院、宿舍及 運動場。當天我們出席簡介會後,便到酒店休息了。
